Holland Track Adventure

3 DAY ADVENTURE/ 2 NIGHTS | \$575/ VEHICLE

An EXPLORE WA favourite, the Holland track adventure provides a real taste of remote area touring only a stonethrow from Perth. Over 3 days, retrace the steps of John Holland, who carved the route over 100 years prior by hand with the help of a small party from Broomehill to Coolgardie. This trip provides a fun and historic insight to remote area touring via one of our states most important bush routes with great camping, 4wding & scenery on offer. The million star sky, great fires & tracks to suit mild to wild means this trip is a winner for everyone.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

The Holland track was originally forged as a cart road link between the port of Albany and the Goldfields back in 1893 for prospectors to access the Goldfields quicker. Reclaimed by agricultural development in the South West and the natural bush to North East, the track was forged once more in 1992 to allow others to experience the region once again. Our trip on the Holland track starts in Hyden, WA ends in Coolgardie.

The ever-changing scenery is refreshing on this lengthy track of over 200km toward Coolgardie. Throughout the length of the track we stop at points of interest to share some history and see around the landscapes, often explaining different pieces of information as we interact with the bush. We will stop and camp each night at select locations amongst the scrub where we you can prepare a camp oven feast over the fire (seasonal), enjoy a drink or two and share a yarn about the day's adventure. Another cool sight on the track is crossing the Rabbit Proof (State Barrier) fence where we will also stop for some photos and share some history of this iconic fence line in Western Australia.

The track in recent years has become a little more challenging with wet weather the biggest factor effecting track conditions out here. Countless bog holes can be accessed and recoveries are a very realistic possibility - be prepared to get dirty if it has been raining! A number of access tracks around major bog holes are available for those who wish to steer clear. It really is a track that can cater to all levels and desires of off roaders.

The changing flora ensures there is always something to look at and the numerous granite outcrops provide great points of interest along our route to jump out, stretch the legs and explore. There is also an abundance of Fauna out here, so keep your eyes peeled!

Terrain on the Holland track depends a lot on the weather. Naturally the predominately single lane track is firm, narrow in places and has numerous sections with deeper ruts and bog holes that can fill up when rain has affected the area. Along the way impressive Granite outcrops rise above the landscape with heavily wooded track sections common. The changing landscape is really a sight to be seen, especially with the native wildlife including thorny devils and a host of other species are spotted frequently!

Epic camping under the million star sky warmed by a cracking mallee fire each night will be a highlight of your trip together with the great 4wding on offer.



YOUR REQUIREMENTS

- Vehicles should be in sound mechanical condition as recoveries can be expensive.
- Ensure your spare tyre is in good condition.
- You need to carry all camping equipment, food, beverages and water. You can hire equipment from us if you do not have your own.
- A minimum of 40L of water per vehicle is required.
- Please also consider waste, as all rubbish will be carried with us.
- Bring extra water if you wish to use our vehicle shower.
- Warm clothing and adequate bedding should be bought along as night temperatures are regularly cool.
- No dogs are permitted. 1080 Baiting is rife out here.
- Air compressor & tyre deflators for your vehicle.
- Two way radio mandatory to communicate with convoy.
- Clothing & bedding for all weather conditions
- Fuel Stops available in Hyden & Coolgardie



TRIP NOTES

Some of our adventures traverse extremely remote country & its imperative your vehicle is in good mechanical condition. Pre trip checks are highly recommended & in some cases mandatory for our adventures depending where we are travelling.
