



Explore WA 4wd Adventures offers you the amazing opportunity to experience one of the best 4wd touring adventures in Western Australia, teaming up with Traditional owner Ronald Morgan & his father Colin (Just Over The Hills) to bring you this once in a lifetime journey in the Far North Kimberley on Ballangarra country.

The Oombulgurri adventure is only suitable for those with solid 4wd'ing experience & a well set up vehicle. Those prepared will be rewarded with access to some amazing spots along the way with local knowledge of those hidden gems on the trip route. Pack the fishing gear as you will get the chance to fish for barra & other bluewater species, swim in stunning water holes & learn about the Aboriginal culture from traditional owners throughout this adventure. Throw in a tough as nails off road 4wd route for the entirety of our journey, rock art, bush tucker and NO CROWDS WHATSOEVER - We are certain you're in for one of the best touring experiences of your life.

As the first people through the track after the wet season, this adventure offers an authentic Kimberley 4wd experience unrivalled by anything else available. The track dicatates the days plan & an easy going & flexible nature is how the trip will flow. To travel this region shortly following the wet you will be witness with flowing creeks, rivers, springs, abundant wildife, full swimming holes & scenery changes at every twist & turn.

Each situation & challenge we come across after the wet season is unique and will ensure you can put your knowledge & experience to the test.

Our 15 day trip is itinerary free, departing Home Valley Station and finishing near Kalumburu, WA's most Northern settlement. YOUR REQUIREMENTS

- Vehicles should be in sound mechanical condition as recoveries will be expensive. Your vehicle should have a pre trip inspection.
- •2 Spare Tyres
- You need to carry all camping equipment, food, beverages and water. Showering/Washing up water can be colected along our trip route from natural sources.
- Spare parts such as alternator brushes & fuel filters & other items specific to your vehicle you know and carry reguarly on remote adventures of extended periods should be bought along.
- No dogs are permitted. No trailers.
 Air compressor & tyre deflators.
- Two way radio mandatory to communicate with convoy. Ensure it is working well.
- Please bring along your favourite bush toilet.
- Extended fuel range required. Contact to discuss your usage requirements on this adventure.
- Snorkel required
- Off Road tyres & Lift Kit mandatory
- Spinifex mesh/screen/shadecloth for front of vehicle will be required.
- You need to carry enough drinking water for 17 days. We recommend at least 40L of drinking water.
- Carry spare fuses for your fridge & two
- Bring your fishing gear & plenty of it!



- -You will want a comprohensive mechanical inspection prior to this adventure due to the distance from home to make sure everything is tickety - boo.
- A grass seed screen is required -Basic spares should be carried & any vehicle specific tools too.

This is a remote area adventure so you will need to carry plenty of drinking water.
