WHAT CAN I EXPECT

Join us on this epic 14-day journey along the famous & equally stunning Gibb River Road, as we lead you on an curated adventure through the breathtaking country that is the Kimberley. The 600+ km Gibb River Road has long been an iconic touring destination offering some spectacular scenery, brilliant 4wding and the chance to immerse in the Kimberleys rich cultural heritage. our trip begins in Derby & finishes at El Questro Wilderness park 14 days later,

Our Tagalong tour traverses the Iconic Gibb River Road as well as a drive to the iconic Mitchell Falls. We deliver a well paced & balanced trip route, that includes some spectacular camping, bushwalks, swimming & experiences like guided rock art tours, private campfire cooking. On your journey you will visit all the must stop areas along the Gibb that epitomise the Kimberley region from National Park Camps, charming Station hospitality & the ever popular Home Valley Station & El Questro wilderness park. Doing it with a small group & experenced local guide ensures you will maximise your time here & be at the front of the pack with local insight & knowledge throughout your journey. You will come away with a more detailed understanding & knowledge of where you have both been & experienced. .

There will also be lots of time for discovering the Kimberley's famous rock formations & rock art. Guided bushwalks through the scrub also provide oppourunity to see bush tucker & learn more about the local flora & fauna. You will also complete those "bucket list" items like the Pentecost River crossing & exploring the Mitchell Plateau's mighty falls.

The stunning Kimberley landscape will be like nothing else you have seen before, with thousands of majestic boab tree's along the trek route, juttred ranges, jump ups & bluffs with palm lined creeks, picturesque rivers and streams lthroughout our adventure.

Our nightly camps will be spent at national park camps and station stays throughout the duration of the trip. All camps have varying facilities which include at minimum toilets. We take care of all formalities so you can just focus on experiencing your surrounds & immerse in the beauty of the region. That means no worrying about camps being full, or the best time to see and do activities - We know what works & we can't wait to share it with you!

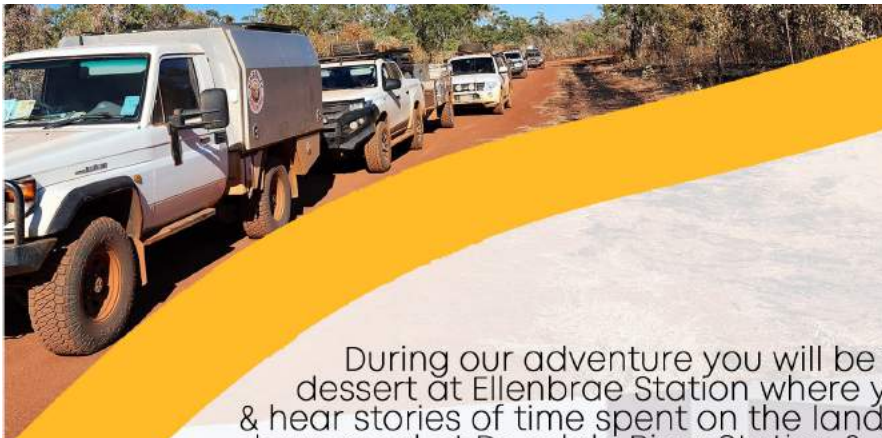
In the early evening our camping will involve a fire, and will undoubtedly be filled with lots of tales and laughter as everyone gets the chance to recap on their days experience.

Our route and planned itinerary has been designed to allow that flexible approach that has become a much loved part of our tours. We have also incorporated rest days into our journey to ensure you get a perfectly balanced adventure - all the hard work done for you so you get the most out of your adventure. Why not take a scenic helicopter flight through the landscape to gain a different perspective or try your hand at some fishing? Join us for a sundowner against the mighty Cockburn Ranges marvelling the surrounding landscape? Rest assured - there are a number of activities available along the way you can enjoy.

Travelling daily in convoy we will explore the region together, crossing the many rivers, creeks, streams, jump up's & dropping into local highlights found throughout the route. The lead guides experience will allow you to experience these points of interest at the right time with stops for lunch, photo opportunities or even a refreshing swim all part of your guides' planning repertoire. Some days will be sleep in's, some days we will be up a bit earlier - all will be communicated around the campfire each evening while on tour. Ultimately, we keep things flexible, relaxed & easy going as you are on HOLIDAY - let us worry about the behind the scenes so you can focus on enjoying yourself!







WHAT CAN I EXPECT

During our adventure you will be treated to a home cooked meal & dessert at Ellenbrae Station where you will sit down with the station team & hear stories of time spent on the land. You will also enjoy a delicious sit down meal at Drysdale River Station & another night off cooking with a dinner provided at Home Valley Station that is included in your trip price.

In keeping with the flexible nature of our adventures a table is reserved in the beer garden at El Questro where you may wish to enjoy a meal from the station bar & enjoy live music. For remaining nights cooking on the open fire is welcomed & we are happy to lend our experience with campfire cooking, including dampers & the like.

Explore WA were the first licensed Tag-a-Long operator to access Mitchell Plateau with Wanambal Gambera Traditional Owners permission. We have a particular fondness of the region & its spectacular natural & cultural wonders.

The Mitchell Plateau is an amazing place of decadent beauty. On all our adventures, guests regularly opt to take a scenic flight in to the Falls & as a group have walked back along one of Australia's most spectacular bushwalks visiting rock art sites, Big Mertens Falls & swimming at Little Mertens Falls. Air Transfer to the falls as of 2023 was a cost of \$190pp* for the 7 minute transfer flight. We don't include this in the trip price as some people may choose to walk each way or do some alternative chopper tours, however we tentatively book the group in with provider Heli Spirit for your convenience & provide you with all the information at time of onboarding.

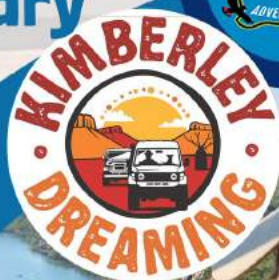

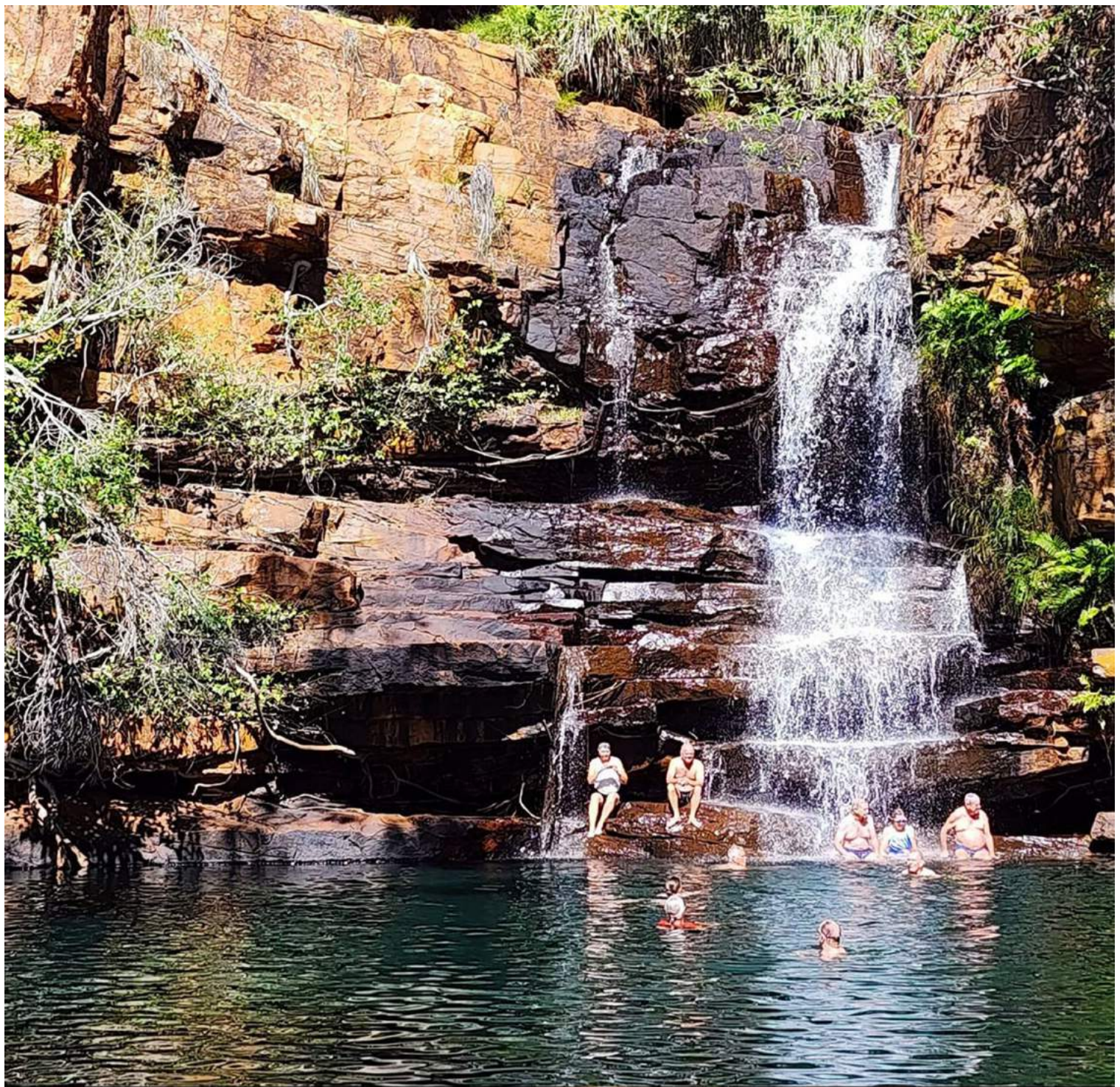

THE MOST FUN FILLED ADVENTURE OF THE GIBB RIVER ROAD



YOUR REQUIREMENTS

- Vehicles should be in sound mechanical condition as recoveries will be extremely expensive. Pre trip inspection required.
- Min 1, pref 2 Spare Tyres of Quality Light Truck AT Construction minimum. Ask us for our tyre recommendations!
- You need to carry all camping equipment, food, beverages and water. Showering or washing up water can be collected along our trip route from natural sources & a number of stations have access to potable water to refill containers. The longest period without access to drinking water is 3 days. Drinking water can be obtained at Windjana, Silent Grove, Mount Barnett, Drysdale, Home Valley & El Questro however you should carry adequate supplies for 3 days in your vehicle at all times for unforeseen circumstances.
- Basic spare parts for your vehicle should be bought along such as an extra fuel & air filter; air filter socks are highly recommended for travel on dusty roads for vehicles fitted with ram head snorkels.
- No dogs are permitted.
- Robust Camper Trailers are permitted, sorry no large caravans.
- Air compressor & tyre deflators.
- Two way radio mandatory to communicate with convoy. Ensure it is working well. You can rent off us.
- There is ample fuel available along the Gibb River Road. You should be able to cover a range of 450km.
- Snorkel is highly recommended not only for the water early in the season, but the dust.
- Bring a small supply of back up cash & gold coins for washing machines.

TRIP INCLUSIONS

Outside of our standard inclusions, a number of extra items are included in your tour booking price. We go into a little more detail below on some of the great things we have planned to add to your experience.

- Take a night off cooking with a sensational dinner available at Drysdale River Station. Enjoy a meal in the grounds of the iconic Bar area at Drysdale River Station & with dessert included.

- Enjoy a guided indigenous walk with Uunguu Rangers on the Mitchell Plateau. This walk has developed now over the years to showcase the art sites around Munurru, nearby our camp area. Guided with the trip leader & lead by indigenous rangers, you will hear about some of the art found here with explanations & stories associated with the artworks, told directly from traditional owners.

Art including Wandjina paintings can be seen here. This is a brilliant way to have access to traditional custodians working to manage their own country, offering a chance to engage, ask questions & hear directly from traditional owners.

- Ellenbrae Station is famous for its scones, but did you know Logan, Larissa & the team offer our group a brilliant camp oven stew & sticky date pudding for our stay! Joining us for dinner, the station team will talk about life on the station & what working, living & operating tourism ventures on the Gibb River Road is like. There is also some insight into the extensive cattle operation here at Ellenbrae. We are camped nearby in the picturesque grounds of the Homestead. This night is a great example of friendly Kimberley hospitality.

- Home Valley Station has the famous Dusty Bar, a long standing destination for travellers wishing to clear the dust from their throats & enjoy a meal at the station restaurant. A main meal is provided here for all guests to enjoy - so take a night off.
