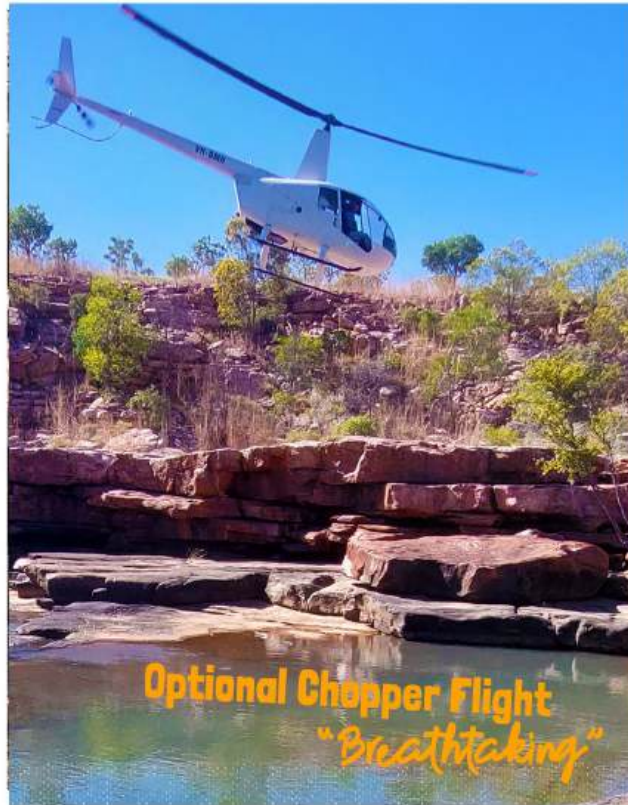
WHAT CAN I EXPECT

Explore WA 4wd Adventures offers a privileged opportunity to experience one of the best 4wd touring adventures in Western Australia, teaming up with Traditional Owners Just Over The Hills for this early season escapade into Balanggarra country. Join us with traditional owners for an early season run up the Oombi track just after the wet season.

Embark on the journey of a lifetime through the magnificent and rugged Kimberley countryside. Prepare to be captivated not only by the breathtaking views outside your window but also by the enchanting stories echoing from the hillsides & through the valleys. This tough as nails touring adventure is demanding but ultimately described as one of the most amazing things people have done from behind the wheel of their 4x4.

Due to the nature of the tracks & conditions our Oombulgurri adventure is only suitable for those with solid 4wd'ing experience & a well set up vehicle. Those prepared for the journey ahead will be rewarded with guided access to country, a world class Indigenous Protected Area, experiencing the raw natural beauty, rugged 4x4'ing, stories & cultural insights throughout the length of the trip. We will also be pushing our expedition into King George Falls toward the end of the trip.

Don't forget to pack the fishing gear as you will get the chance to fish for barra & other bluewater species along the way as well as swimming in stunning water holes, visiting amazing rock art, hearing stories of traditional life & the actual story of the Oombulgurri people through the eyes of those who lived through it. As this is an exclusive adventure off limits to the public there is NO CROWDS WHATSOEVER! We are certain you're in for one of the best 4x4 touring experiences of your life.



WHAT CAN I EXPECT

Our early season trips embark the after the wet season in Mid May, this adventure offers multiple river crossings, rugged rock jump up's, trackless sandy creek beds & roof high spear grass that totally engulfs us on sections of the track. Billabongs, black soil country & tidal marshes all offer their own unique challenges on the track. Our progress on the track is simply dictated by the track itself & we don't have a set itinerary - the track dictates our progress. To travel this region shortly following the wet you will witness more flowing creeks, rivers, springs, great swimming holes & scenery changes at every twist & turn - it is simply spectacular at any time of year, but more challenging earlier in the season.

Each situation & challenge we come across after the wet season is unique and will ensure you can put your knowledge & experience to the test while pitching in & contributing to getting the group through obstacles as we face them along the track.

Our 15 day trip is itinerary free & may take a day extra or a day less depending on the season. Departing Home Valley Station and finishing near Kalumburu on the Carson River, days of exceptional 4wd touring await as well as some of the best sunrises & sunsets you ever likely to see this side of the sun. Camping under the stars each night with a great fire & plenty of laughs about the days travels compliments the days events. It's not all go though, there are some amazing rest periods spent in some handpicked areas where you can really get the chance to soak it all up on 2 night stays. There will also be lots of local insights, stories & bushcraft & tool making.

Described by previous guests as the biggest tick off their 4wd bucket list the diversity, challenges, scenery, history & culture of the Oombulgurri adventure coupled with our signature tour atmosphere delivers one of the best 4wd adventures available in Australia today.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT -continued

Traditional Culture covers many facets of life, which on this tour, you will have the privilege to learn about direct from the custodians. The Morgan family have approval to not only guide you through sacred country but to explain & teach principals from this ancient way of life!

On this adventure you will get to experience

- Significant historical sites where ceremony's took place, battles were fought & great damage was caused to Indigenous people during the colonization period.
- Dream Time Stories
- Rock Art & what art means to Indigenous people .Traditional Tool Making such as spears + didg.
- Aim to travel into King George Falls by vehicle & hike & swim the return 1.8km walk.
- Authentic 4wd touring across a range of terrains. • Raw Kimberley wilderness after the wet season. • Fresh & Saltwater fishing in untouched river systems with absolutely NO fishing pressure! Earlier in the season is better for fishing!
- + So much more on your journey through Balanggarra country.

This small group tour will enjoy a relaxed atmosphere with a fun, engaging enviroment. 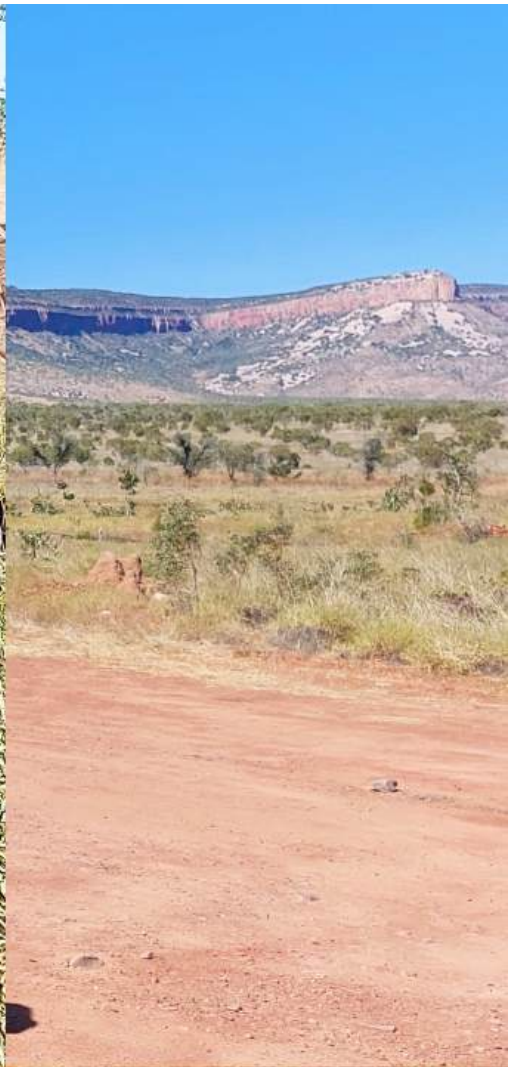

YOUR REQUIREMENTS

This adventure is a challenging off road pilgrimage as we tackle the area each year after the wet season. The last time this track saw a machine was in the 1990's; each year after the wet season, nature shapes the creeks, rivers, streams, banks and tracks offering unique challenges from season to season. From open grassy plains, rocky jump up's, multiple river crossings & its remote, off grid nature, this adventure is only suitable for those with experience spending extended times off grid with vehicles that are well set up for robust 4x4 touring.

VEHICLE SET UP:

Vehicles should be in sound mechanical condition as recoveries will be expensive & difficult to effect. A pre trip inspection should be carried out by a 4x4 service specialist. Spares to suit your vehicle you would ordinarily carry when remote touring should be bought along, together with fuses for both your vehicle, fridges, two way radio's and any specific tools for your vehicle you may ordinarily need.

Ensure you have 2 spare tyre(s) that are in good condition. Quality offroad tyres are required (Minimum LT All Terrain) at 33' or equivalent being the bare minimum.

Absolutely no 18' rims or any other low profile rubber sizes - they will not last.

A lift kit is mandatory, either 2' or above together with protection such as underbody bash plates & a bullbar. We do recommend rock sliders, side steps & scrub bars to protect sills for extra protection. A winch is required for self recovery & lending help if required.

Good driving techniques will go a long way to safe passage through the track & help will be on hand to spot & guide as required which is why this is not a trip for the inexperienced operator.

All vehicle set up's will be questioned and assessed as suitable for the trip.

WATER:

We recommend bringing along 40L of water for drinking. There is access to natural sources to top up as required, which often provide perfect quality drinking water, but with any natural source it is a good idea to purify the water so consider purification methods that will work for you. Contact for more info.

Water for showering & washing can be collected regularly along the track, so we recommend bringing a 10L or 20L container exclusively for this purpose.

FOOD:

You need to bring all food supplies with you. There will be the chance to catch fish & supplement supplies, but coming prepped for the full trip will ensure redundancy. In your past travel experience off grid, you will know methods like pre cooking & kryovac packaging meals will make things a lot easier.

WASTE:

You will need to carry your rubbish with you on the trip. We will be able to dig a hole at the old tip site roughly mid way through your trip and burn paper based products as we go, however you will need to retain plastics and other hard wastes. A good quality canvas wheel bag or similar is recommended.



YOUR REQUIREMENTS

COOKING ARRANGEMENT:

We have fire's every night & we'll have the hotplate on hand to cook over the fire. Feel free to use this as it is communal.

ALL VEHICLES MUST HAVE ON BOARD:

- 2.5L Water Sprayer
- Fire Extinguisher
- Metal Coat Hanger
- Good humour
- General Use Gloves
- Welding Glove(s)

FIRST AID:

We ask all persons to include their medications & a basic kit. Trip leaders carry first aid supplies, emergency communication equipment, etc.

FUEL:

Fuel Usage varies from vehicle to vehicle. Departing Home Valley, the trip is just over 500KM in mainly low range. Next fuel is available in Kalumburu or South at Drysdale Station upon finishing the track. Prior to arriving at Home Valley the last fuel available is at El Questro Station around 55km away.

Long run times throughout the day and a duration of 15 days means you will still use much more fuel than you think. Below is some past information on usage for vehicles from Home Valley Station to Kalumburu. These are a guide only.

V8 70 Series - 168L | 1HZ 100 Series - 150 L | Nissan Patrol Brunswick Diesel - 220L
Toyota Hilux D4D - 135L | Turbo 1HZ 100 Series 180L | Ford Ranger 165L | 200 Series 175L

Petrol vehicles must consider wrapping their exhaust or having components ceramic coated; hot temps of a catalytic converter on dry grass can be a recipe for disaster, in much the same way as a forced burn in a new diesel fitted with a DPF. Regardless, all vehicles travelling carry items in the case any vehicle have grass build up. Contact us direct for more info. It is of note we have never had an issue but we would rather be prepared in this remote area.

ALCOHOL:

Is permitted on the trip. Consume with respect

CLOTHING/BEDDING

Bring a range of clothing for all weather. usually, the weather is still nice and balmy warm however we can get cool nights sometimes. Bring thongs and sturdy shoes/boots as well, if you enjoy walking bring a camelback for fishing missions..

TOILETS:

Feel free to bring your favoured bush loo. BYO Shovel, bury human waste deep & burn toilet paper. Traditional Owners ask you respect country, others & yourself..

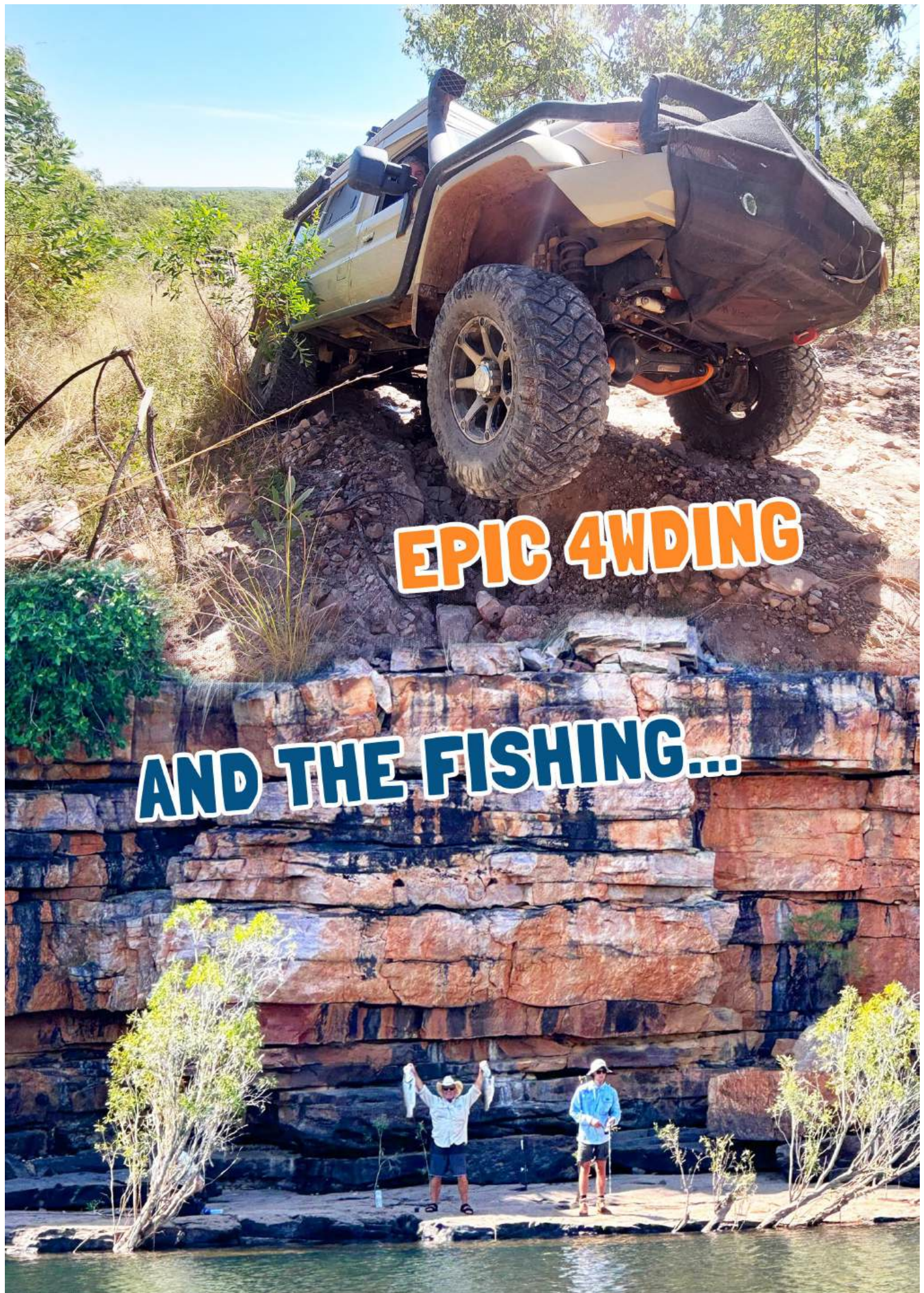

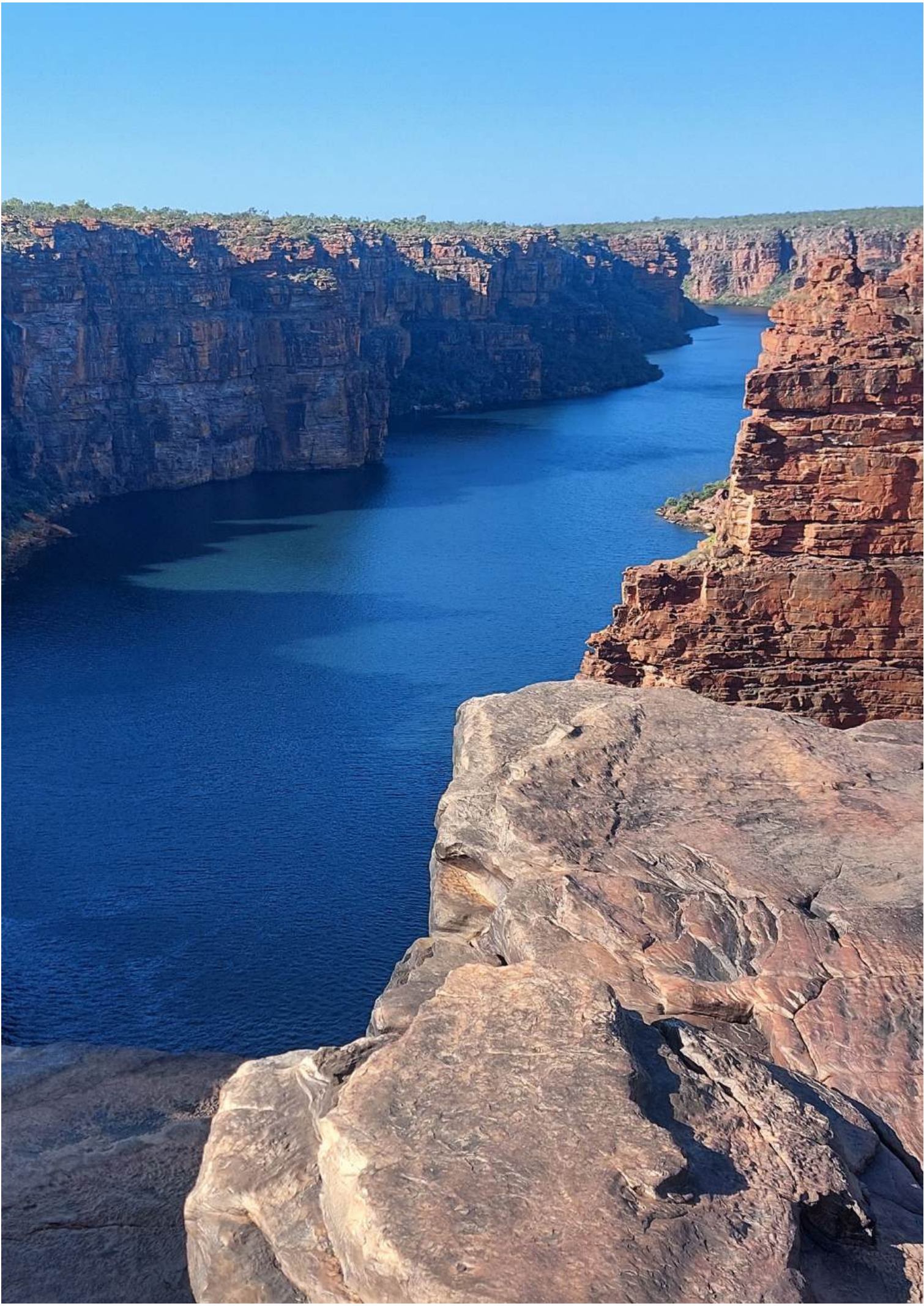




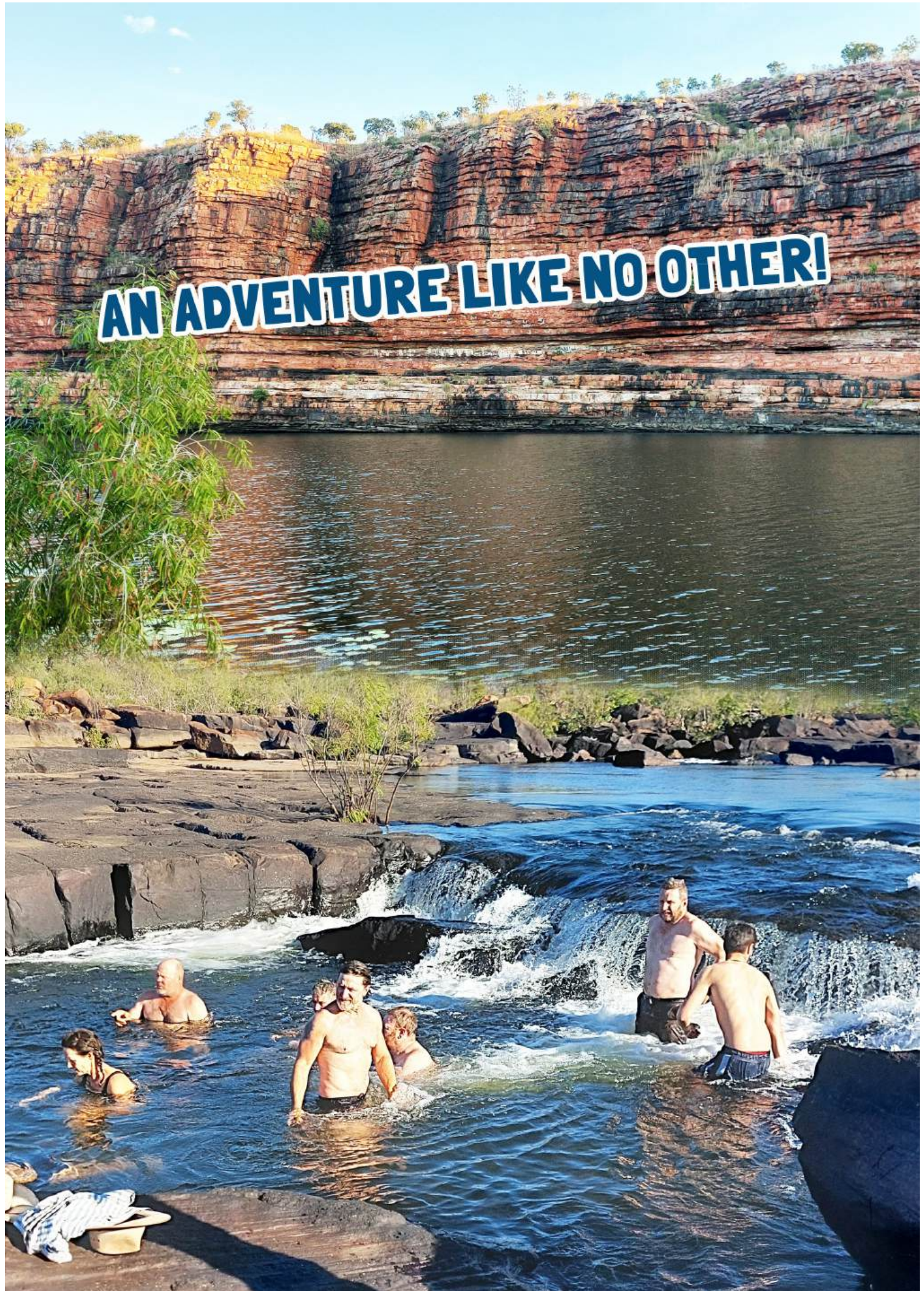
